SPEAKER BIO:

After Sandy obtained her RN Diploma from St. Michael's School of Nursing in Toronto, she moved back to Kingston. Sandy worked in Paediatric Nursing for 15 years at KGH, until moving into Neuro nursing and became involved with Clinical Research with many drug trials in Epilepsy, migraine, Subarachnoid Hemorrhage, Parkinson, Memory Disorders, and Herpes Encephalitis. Also, during this time Sandy held the position of Coordinating the Canadian Stroke Registry for Eastern Ontario.

While working in research she was also the Coordinator of the Movement Disorder Clinic for 25 years, after which she became more involved in the Epilepsy Clinic. It became apparent there was a need for someone to answer calls and look after prescription renewals for patients. Phone support for patients with epilepsy was a positive addition to the Epilepsy clinic and can relieve stress and can save a clinic visit. April 2018, KHSC opened the Epilepsy Monitoring Unit (EMU), so now Sandy also helps with coordinating the patients for the unit and follow-ups after discharge.
