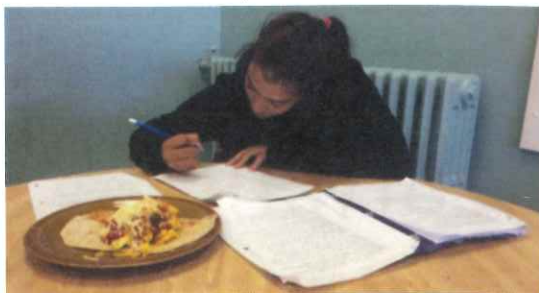
Earn your High School Diploma

- Transition to college through Dual Credit and OYAP programs (for students under 21)

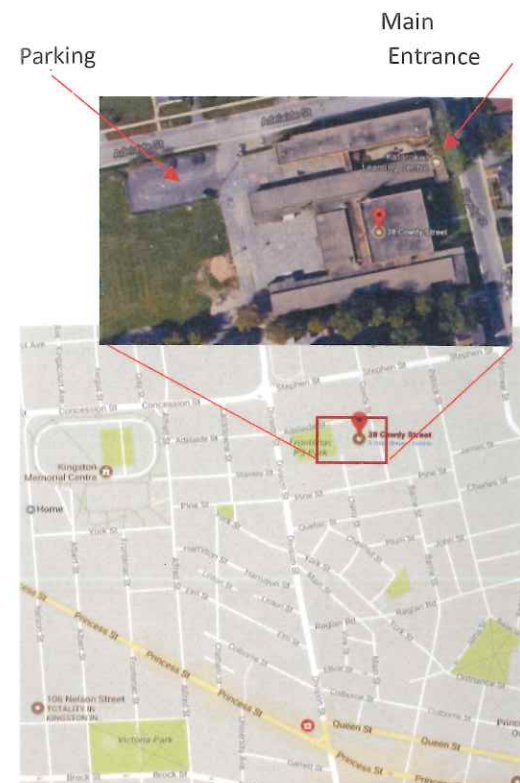
