Greetings LEAP applicants. As part of the LEAP Workshop application process you and your preassigned group will be asked to create a short theatrical performance that includes elements of drama, music and movement. We are not going to give you specific details at this time. (It's a secret.)

No previous knowledge or experience is required for this performance task. We will be evaluating the process...not the product.

However, we are asking each applicant to have a basic knowledge of the following terms and how they might be applied in your performance.

You will also notice a music file attached. This music mix is part of your presentation piece. Make yourself familiar with this piece.

DRAMA

Tableau- a depiction of a scene usually presented on a stage by silent and motionless costumed participants

Elements of Tableau

Communication body language, facial expression, related to theme

Levels high, medium, low

Body shape open, closed, balance, linear, round

Relationship to up-stage, down stage

stage and others

MUSIC

Dynamics Loud, soft, getting louder, getting softer

Tempo Fast, slow

Texture Instrument combinations

DANCE/MOVEMENT

Space through which the body moves (general or personal space, level,

size, direction, pathway)

Time is applied to music and dance (beat, tempo, speed, rhythm, sudden, slow,

sustain)

Force/Energy sharp, strong, light, heavy, free-flow

Relationship of dancers' body to others, to space, to time, to music
