Voluntary Self-Identification

for students with First Nations, Métis and Inuit ancestry

The benefits of Self-Identification include:

- Provide students with First Nations, Métis
 and Inuit ancestry access to opportunities, resources
 and support they may need to reach their goals.
- · Access to cultural programming.
- Access for students to information about leadership experiences and post-secondary pathways.



What is the process of Self-Identification?

- The process is voluntary and confidential. Self-Identification can be withdrawn at any time.
- This Self-Identification is based on any degree of Indigenous ancestry and no proof is required.
- Parents/Guardians of children under 18 years of age are able to Self-Identify their children as having First Nations, Métis, or Inuit ancestry.
- Students over 18 years of age are able to Self-Identify as having First Nations, Métis, or Inuit ancestry.
