4. Terms of Reference	Reviewed changes to the Terms of Reference (TOR) based on feedback received from Committee members in January 2022. In addition to changing language to reflect life promotion practices, the working group will focus on ways to make the protocol more accessible and more user friendly. 8. LDSB Mental Health and Wellness Website Review	Feedback from the Mental Health Strategy Survey was that the LDSB website is not easy to navigate. Both the KFL&A Child and Youth Mental Health Family Advisory Committee (FAC) and Limestone District School Board (LDSB) Parent Involvement Committee (PIC) have provided feedback to the Mental Health Lead about how we can better organize the Mental Health & Wellness pages of the site, and how to make them easier to navigate and more relevant to caregivers. The Mental Health Lead will work with LDSB Communications over the spring and summer to incorporate the feedback of the various committees. There is an expectation from both the FAC and PIC that LDSB reports back to them with the changes that were made. This will take place in the fall.	L. Conboy
